Goal 1: We will design an engaging and challenging curriculum that develops each student's ability to read, write, think, and defend.

Performance Objective 1: We will increase by 5% the number of students performing at approaches, meets grade level, and masters in all tested subject areas for all student groups.

Goal 2: We will provide students with multiple avenues for specialized instruction and opportunities to advance at their own pace.

Performance Objective 1: We will increase the percentage of LEP and Special Education student groups scoring at the "Approaching Grade Level" by 5% on the English STAAR/EOC.

Performance Objective 2: We will increase the number of students who are enrolled in the following college-readiness courses: Advanced Placement, Dual Enrollment, and Dual Credit by 5%
